

**ASCLERA® (POLIDOCANOL) INJECTION STAND AND DELIVER CONTEST (THE “CONTEST”)
OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This Contest is intended for viewing and participation in the 50 United States and Washington D.C. only and shall be construed and evaluated according to the laws of the 50 United States and Washington D.C. Please do not enter if you are not a legal resident of, and not located in the 50 United States or Washington D.C. at time of entry. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING.

1. **CONTEST PERIOD:** Starting October 28, 2011 at 12:00:00 AM Central Time (CT) and ending April 15, 2012 at 11:59:59 PM CT (the "Contest Period"). The Contest Period will be divided into three sub-periods: the **Entry Period** (from October 28, 2011 at 12:00:00 AM CT to January 15, 2012 at 11:59:59 PM CT), the **Judging Period** (from January 16, 2012 at 12:00:00 AM CT to February 19, 2012 at 11:59:59 PM CT), and the **Online Voting Period** (February 20, 2012 at 12:00:00 AM CT to April 15, 2012 at 11:59:59 PM CT). Grand Prize Winner will be announced by May 15, 2012.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** To enter and be eligible to win, you must (a) be a legal resident of the 50 United States, or Washington, D.C., (b) be 18 years of age or older, and (c) have a valid email address. Persons in any of the following categories are NOT eligible to participate or win prizes: i) any person who, at any time on or after October 28, 2011, was or is a director, officer, or employee of Merz Aesthetics, Inc. (the “Sponsor”), or its parent, subsidiaries, franchisees, agents, suppliers or service agencies, including Medical Dynamics and Etna Interactive; (ii) individuals engaged in the development, production or distribution of materials for the Contest or engaged in the administration or execution of this Contest (collectively with the entities in 2(i), the "Contest Entities"), and (iii) persons who reside in the same household (i.e., live in the same household for at least 3 of the 12 months preceding the start of the Contest Period, whether related or not) as any person in any of the preceding categories.

 - 3.1. **Entry Period (October 28, 2011 at 12:00:00 AM CT to January 15, 2012 at 11:59:59 PM CT):** During the Entry Period, visit the Contest page at www.Asclera.com/standanddeliver (the “Website”) and follow the instructions to register, including reading and accepting these Official Rules. Then upload a short mandatory paragraph (up to 200 words), in English, nominating a person committed to family and community and who takes a stand by working hard to make a difference (a “Nominee”), explaining why and how you think the person has made such difference (a “Paragraph” or a “Nomination”) (see Section #3.1.1 for Submission Requirements and Section #3.2 for Judging Criteria). A Nomination should include name, email address and/or phone number of Nominee. **You cannot nominate yourself. Please note: your Nominee will have to meet all eligibility requirements described in Rule #2 above. Limit of one (1) registration and one (1) unique Nomination per person/per email address.** If it is discovered that you have registered or attempted to register more than **ONCE** or have attempted to register multiple times using multiple identities or email addresses or have attempted to submit more than one Nomination, all of your Nominations will be declared null and void, and any prize you or your Nominee might have been entitled to will not be awarded. If after the Judging Period (see Section #3.2 below) your Nominee is selected as a finalist, the Nominee will be contacted by email (using the email address you provided with your Nomination) and they will have to accept your Nomination (and also accept and agree with these Official Rules) before your Nomination is

deemed acceptable by the Sponsor or its agents.

Each Nomination will be screened by the Sponsor or its agents for eligibility (see Submission Requirements below). Nominations that do not meet the Submission Requirements or were declined by the Nominee will be automatically disqualified in the sole discretion of the Sponsor. Nominations become the property of Sponsor and will not be returned.

Nominators (by submitting a Nomination) and Nominees (by accepting such Nomination) agree to indemnify and hold Contest Entities (as defined in Rule #2) from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, damages, costs or expenses brought against or suffered or incurred by the Contest Entities, or any of them, arising out of or in connection with the participation by the Nominators and Nominees in this Contest, any breach by the Nominators or the Nominees of the foregoing warranties or agreements or the use, in whole or in part, by any Contest Entity of any Nomination (or portion thereof) submitted by the Nominators (and accepted by the Nominees) in this Contest. By submitting a Nomination, Nominators agree that their submission is gratuitous and made without restriction, and will not place Sponsor under any obligation, that Sponsor is free to disclose the Nomination and the ideas contained in it on a non-confidential basis to anyone or otherwise use the ideas without any additional compensation to Nominators. Nominators and Nominees acknowledge that, by acceptance of a Nomination, Sponsor does not waive any rights to use similar or related ideas previously known to Sponsor, or developed by its employees, or obtained from sources other than Nominators or Nominees. By submitting a Nomination, Nominators warrant and represent that it: (a) is their original work, (b) has not been previously published/broadcast, (c) has not won previous awards, (d) does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity; and (e) and that publication of the Paragraph via various media including Web posting, will not infringe on the rights of any third party. Any such Nominator (and their Nominee) will indemnify and hold harmless Sponsor and Contest Entities from any claims to the contrary. any brand or product of any kind other than the Sponsor's, including, but not limited to, any of Sponsor's competitors, or contain any personal identification, such as personal names, e-mail addresses or street addresses;

(vii) The Nomination cannot contain trademarks, copyrighted works, or any intellectual property other than as owned by entrant or than as authorized by Sponsor for use by entrants in connection with this Contest;

(viii) The Nomination cannot violate or depict any violation of any law or otherwise be inappropriate; all as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion.

3.2. Judging Period (January 16, 2012 at 12:00:00 AM CT to February 19, 2012 at 11:59:59 PM

CT): During the Judging Period, an independent qualified judging organization ("Contest Judges") will judge all eligible Nominations received during the Entry Period based on the Criteria below and select three (3) Nominations (whose Nominees will collectively be the "Finalists"). All Nominations will be judged based on the following criteria: degree of difference made by the Nominee in his/her community (25%); degree of commitment of Nominee to family and community (25%), ability of Nominee to inspire others (25%), passion/enthusiasm of Nominee (25%). An additional "tie-breaking" Contest Judge will break any eventual ties, based on the criteria listed herein. The Contest Judges' decisions shall be final and binding. The Contest Entities will attempt to contact all three Nominees contained in the Finalists' submissions to verify their compliance with these Official Rules and to obtain their authorization to use their name and personal information for the purposes of the Contest. 3.3. Online Voting Period (February 20, 2012 at 12:00:00 AM CT to April 15, 2012 at 11:59:59

PM CT): During the Online Voting Period, the general public will be able to vote for one (1) of the three verified Finalists based on the Criteria outlined in Section 3.2 above. You must register in order to vote. To register, during the Online Voting Period visit the Website, follow the instructions to register (including reading and accepting these Official Rules), then click the "Vote" button for your favorite Nominee and, by doing so, you will cast one (1) vote for that Nominee and also receive one (1) entry into the applicable Weekly Sweepstakes Draw (see Section 3.1.1 for details). On your next visits to the Website, you will not need to register again, but you will need to log-in using the login credentials you set up during the registration process. You may cast only one (1) vote per day. (For purposes of counting votes, each "day" will start at 12:00:00 AM CT and end at 11:59:59 PM CT.) Any votes that exceed these limits or votes generated by script, macro or other automated means or with the intent to impair the integrity of the voting process, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, will be void. Any waiver of any obligation hereunder by Sponsor does not constitute a general waiver of any obligation to entrants.

3.3.1. **Weekly Sweepstakes:** the Online Voting Period will be divided into eight (8) Weekly Sweepstakes Periods, as follows:

Approximately ten days after the end of each of the eight Weekly Sweepstakes Periods, at approximately 2:00:00 PM CT, an independent judging organization (the “Sweepstakes Draw Judges”) will randomly draw one entry (each a “Potential Weekly Sweepstakes Winner” and, if verified, a “Weekly Sweepstakes Winner”) from among all eligible entries received, for a total of eight (8) Potential Weekly Sweepstakes Winners (“Weekly Sweepstakes Draw”).
